Call to Order: 7:14 pm by Chair Joe Brazill

Committee Members Present: Joe Brazill, Tony Moreci, Meesa Anders, George Wild

Committee Members Absent:

Approval of agenda by Brazill, second by Moreci Pass 4:0

Approval of minutes: by Wild, second by Moreci Pass 4:0 with change that Movies in the Park on December 21, 2025 did not occur.

Old Business

a. Review Tree Lighting Event. Due to an electrical problem, the City fixed a hole in the conduit so the electrical has been fixed. The bridge needs to have the light bulbs fixed, since they are old fluorescent bulbs, a new solution may be necessary.

b. Caboose updates: The City weatherized the cupula. George will follow-up with the craftsperson regarding cost estimates. We need to come up with a budget before we can really request funding.

c. Bridge IGA: Gate is on hold. The City is working with Lane County to come up with a shared agreement for maintenance since the old agreement has expired.

d. City Cleanup: The City (Max) will approach Weyerhaeuser since they would like to be more involved in this years cleanup, so that a time can be scheduled such as in June of this year.

New Business

a. Bridge and Tree Lighting Event: The City Manager (Max) is getting quotes for a permanent Holiday tree in Rolling Rock park. One quote was \$3-5000 for a live tree.

b. Cleaning headstones in Cemetery: George will approach an individual in town who knows how to complete headstone cleaning and perhaps we can include it in the next city clean up day.

Other Business:

a. Projects for the city: By next meeting, Max would like a list of higher cost parks programs/projects that he can propose to the City Council for the budget.

b. Railroad park and Orchard park: The railroad park is on hold. Orchard park is part of the City parks. We also discussed using the property near Rolling Rock park during Blackberry Jam but this may not be possible due to liability issues since it is private property now.
