Call to Order: 6:00 P.M. by Vice-Chairman Hall O'Regan

Approval of the minutes for February 4, 2016 – Approved by consensus. Jim Burford and Maggie Osgood abstained.

Old Business:

- **Movies/Music in Rolling Rock Park** – Don Swain's Band will be performing in the park in June. CA mentioned a possible lead for a local band, George Wild will follow up. Discussion on movies in the park followed, will check on licensing requirements.
- **Master Park Plan** - Hall O'Regan gave a report from Subcommittee Meeting (Warren Weathers, George Wild and Hall O'Regan). Discussion followed, Tristan Woodhurst would like to develop a Horseshoe Pit for his Eagle Scout Project. Plans are to remove metal slides to make room for the horseshoe pit and to remove the two old cotton wood trees.

New Business:
